**A contingency plan to cover inclement weather conditions**

According to the Hong Kong Observatory, a super typhoon “Mangkhut” will be entering the South China Sea this Saturday and then move quickly towards the coast of Guangdong. Mangkhut is expected to bring adverse weather conditions to Hong Kong on Sunday.

Considering the safety of all players, game officials, working staff members and related partners, kindly find attached an updated tournament schedule for your information.

**Points to Note Under the New Tournament Schedule**

1. Given that the tournament schedule has been shortened, the lowest ranked team in Group A and Group B as well as the third and fourth ranked teams in the Women’s Division will only play **3 games** in total (attached with an updated tournament schedule).
2. The awards presentation(s) will be held on-site at Mega Ice, Mega Box after each final game.
3. Tournament transportation – shuttle buses will be provided for all teams and staff members to and from the Panda Hotel and Mega Box.
4. For flight rescheduling arrangements and extension of stay at the Panda Hotel in case of the typhoon warning signal No. 8 or higher is hoisted, contact the Guest Services Manager at 9090 7827.

**Information for Inclement Weather Conditions in HK (when typhoon warning signal No. 8 or higher is hoisted)**

- Players and core staff members will be required to return to the Panda Hotel by shuttle bus
- Players and staff members are recommended to stay indoors
- Other than core staff members, all other employees are not required to report for duty when the typhoon warning signal No. 8 is hoisted

Although there are still uncertainties in its track, Mangkhut is expected to bring adverse weather to Hong Kong on Sunday with frequent squalls and heavy rain according to the present forecast track.
